PRESIDENT MACRON RECEIVES MACKY SALL PRESIDENT OF SENEGAL AT ELYSEE

DISCUSSION ON CLIMATE CHANGE & TERRORISM

USPA NEWS - "Our two countries have history and also a rebalanced partnership during our exchange, because we face these common challenges : Fundamentalism, and the regional imbalances we see. We share the durable solution to reverse the terrorism threat," said President of the French Republic Emmanuel Macron-----

The first challenge is to continue to "conduct a military strategy with Senegal and with ECOWAS and other forums by continuing the struggle against destabilisation - such as that evokes with Guinea Bissau- and participate in stabilisation of the region". The second challenge is that of "global warming and fighting for climate change, as our two countries to affirm the Paris agreement by our common actions and through our regions". Explained President Emmanuel Macron during the Brief Press at Salle des Fetes, after having a long conversation with President of Senegal Macky Sall, hosted at Elysee Palace on June 11th.

A NEW TYPE OF BALANCED PARTNERSHIP DECLARES PRESIDENT MACRON-----

President Emmanuel Macron also spoke of the "common challenges" and of this new type of "balanced partnership", with "more growth, employment, education, engagement of civil society and on both sides ". This is the first time that a French head of state speaks of a "balanced partnership", recalling the ideas of "co-development" evoked by President Chirac, who was a great Head of State who was very much committed to Africa.-----**EXAMPLE OF ACTION IN EDUCATION TRAINING AND FIGHT AGAINST FUNDAMENTALISM-----**

Action is to be implemented in order to prevent emergence of terrorism through development and consolidation via AFD (Agence France Développement), and structuring with Senegal, which has strong action on education and benefits from "remarkable growth and economic attractiveness". The French head of state also spoke of the Senegalese progress of the urban plan and in particular the project of Train Express of Dakar, under construction.

French President Macron also referred to bilateral projects concerning "Civil Aviation and the revival of Air Senegal, Digital and Defense". He also stressed the climate change and the importance of supporting the Paris Agreement, of 2015, signed at le Bourget and the renewable energy projects that will be the concrete translation, of it.-----

PRESIDENT MACKY SALL WELCOMES FRANCE TO KEEP LEADERSHIP OF PARIS AGREEMENT-----

The Senegalese head of state began by congratulating President Macron after his "brilliant election campaign" and recalled that the special day of this meeting of June 11 coincides with the 1 st round of the legislative elections. We are betting on the future of renewable energies, in common and the super computer of digital. "At COP21 Africa spoke with a single voice, which the industrialized countries had to contribute from the bottom Green and Africa contributes only 4% of global pollution. We are jealous of the Paris Agreement, "acknowledged President Sall who added that he wants France to retain the leadership of the Paris Accord.

This is additional support since President Trump declared a week ago, "Removing the US from the Paris Accord" on climate change. President Macron had reacted immediately by making an official declaration from the Palace of the Elysee. He had also made a message in English, to the Americans, their President Trump and by extension to the resounding Anglophone world in the form of a video. On the French side, the heads of state, meeting the new President Macron, at the Elysée, all positioned themselves in support and alongside France with the Paris Agreement. Thus, the Prime Minister of India, then the President of Cote D'Ivoire, Alassane Ouattara, and the President of Senegal, Macky Sall, at this meeting. PRESIDENT MACKY SALL CONFIRMS WIN WIN RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN FRANCE AND SENEGAL

President Sall recalled the exceptional bilateral cooperation between the two countries, and that President Macron "will give a boost", "ten contracts signed last December in the previous five years. He also insisted on the Regional Express Train "which will revolutionize West Africa and give a picture of a balanced and win-win Franco-African partnership"

For a modern future, which binds us for our youth and populations "-----

President Macky Sall also explained the efforts made in his country, particularly in the sectors of agriculture, education, vocational training, also through the AFD. "We will strengthen the defense and the fight against terrorism for your operation Sarbacane in Mali which is to underline," added President Sall. He concluded "Senegal is engaged in the fight against terrorism in the Sahel and how to accompany the region with ECOWAS and the G5 Sahel and the G7 and Africa will not be the soft belly towards Libya and the rest of the Sahel "About the terrorism that has been spreading over the past few years.

President Macron also confirmed that he will be present at the next G5 of the Sahel which will take place on July 5th ... /
